My son Ben is having a long-awaited surgery for a below-the-knee amputation (left side) on Friday, April 8, at 8:00 a.m. EST. This comes after a three-year fight against a bone infection. He is also currently recovering from a broken left elbow following a fall at home, and from eye surgery in March which included a corneal transplant in the right eye and in which there now appears to be an infection brewing. Ben has lost sight in both eyes due to a different infection and the left eye will also require a corneal transplant.

Prayer is requested for;

- wisdom for all medical staff involved in treating him and especially for the surgeon on Friday morning and the nursing staff during his hospitalization
- complete healing of the residual left limb in a timely manner and minimal pain during recovery and in the future
- strength and continued healing in the left elbow so that he may comfortably use crutches
- protection of the right foot and leg so that it will remain healthy
- eradication of the eye infection and successful healing of the right eye so that he will have some restored vision
- continued patience, perseverance, and provision of HIS peace, which has been supplied in abundance, and which truly surpasses all understanding! Praise the Lord!
- Jesus to be glorified and receive all of the praise, whatever the outcomes!!
