This morning a 7.2 earthquake hit the southwest part of Haiti, around the cities of Jeremie and Les Cayes. Edlers and OMS-related ministries in the north felt tremors but are safe.

There is widespread damage and this reminds many of the 2010 earthquake that hit Port au Prince and the southern peninsula. Haiti now has another humanitarian disaster on top of the political upheaval and Covid. Pray that help will arrive quickly and get to those who need it, in spite of these obstacles. Uphold the first responders in prayer.

- Pray for Divine interventions for those injured and trapped. May they see God's power on their behalf and choose to follow Him. Pray for Christian leaders across the country to have God's wisdom and strength to lead people to God, the source of strength and comfort.
- Pray that those struggling with memories of the 2010 earthquake will turn to God for emotional and psychological healing. Ask God to use Christians to reach out with help and comfort.

Caribbean Field

The leader of a large group of churches in a Caribbean country is suffering with a serious case of Covid. Others in his family and about twenty of the pastors in that group are also sick. Medical help is not readily available to them. Please pray for God's healing touch, through His direct intervention and/or through medical help. Ask God to use the suffering of these days to turn many people to Himself.

Pray that God's children will not give in to discouragement but strengthen themselves and others with God's promises to be with them.
