Haiti Missionaries

OMS leadership has decided that ALL OMS missionaries in Haiti should evacuate as soon as possible. They were hoping that Missionary Flights International would be given permission to pick them up today. Pray that MFI and the Haitian authorities would be able to make this work as Haiti has closed all its airports.

Pray for all the missionaries as they leave abruptly and as they make connections in Florida to reach their homes, especially Colleen Taylor and Edlers as they will more international flights. Edlers were planning to return to North Ireland. Ask God to give them deep heart peace, keep them safe and make them His messengers to fellow travellers.

Missionary Flights International was able to evacuate all the OMS folks who come from North America, including Colleen Taylor, today. But Bill and Julie, with Sam, Joel, and Jakob were left behind as they are British citizens! Added to the stress of the situation they are now the only missionaries on the campus. Pray earnestly for the Edlers, for God's peace to keep their hearts and minds, for grace to trust that God is in control, and for a way to return to North Ireland. Pray also for their families in No. Ireland and Canada as they watch, wait and pray.

COVID-19

The list is endless:

Pray for government leaders to make wise decisions that will benefit their people.
Pray for front-line workers both medical and in the supply chains for food and medicine.
Pray against the instinct to hoard.

Pray for families cooped up together, some under great financial stress that can lead to domestic violence.
