Christian ministries have been the target of gang activity these days in Haiti. Four Sundays in a row, bandits entered four different evangelical churches in Port-au-Prince and killed a deacon, kidnapped pastors and terrorized church members.

17 missionaries and their children are still being held ransom by one of these gangs today.

This is why more than 200 churches in Cap-Haitian are using our voices to cry out to the Lord through prayer and fasting for 3 consecutive days, October 29, 30, and 31. On November 1, the people of God in the north will march around the city and boldly ask God to intervene.

Please pray with us against the kingdom of darkness! Please intervene with us, on Haiti's behalf, on behalf of all who are suffering, on behalf of all the 600+ victims of kidnapping and their families in Haiti since January, on behalf of our brothers and sisters here!
