Please pray for Steve Rehner's youngest daughter Allison, 27 years old. It has been discovered that she has a heart condition that requires open heart surgery. It is scheduled for 1:00 pm today.

There is an aneurism in her aorta that has ballooned to 7.5 centimeters, where a normal aorta should only be 3.5-4.0 centimeters. In addition, her aortic valve is not working properly, so there is a lot of leaking around the heart. From the General Practitioner, to the Cardiologist, to the Surgeon, the seriousness of the situation has crystalized in only a few weeks.

I wanted to let you know so that you can pray with us tomorrow as the surgery starts, asking the Lord for His healing, and for His wisdom for the surgeon and the team who will perform the surgery at the University of Kentucky Medical Center. Pam and I will be grateful for your prayers, and for the prayers of God's people everywhere.
