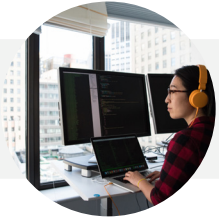

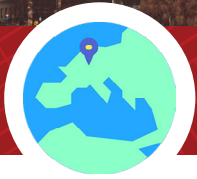

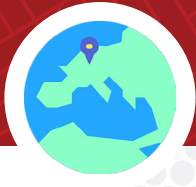

Leveraging and building upon our strong Village Church Planting (VCP) work in Côte d'Ivoire during 2023, we will be launching a new initiative in partnership with three indigenous church denominations and mission organizations. We are in the process of building a team around our project leader, and we are seeking to fill two key roles as described below.



WEST AFRICA MISSIONARY MOVEMENT COORDINATOR

Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire

This role will be assigned to the West Africa Mission Coalition Project. The vision of this project team is to partner with the evangelical national church to motivate and equip nationals for near- and cross-cultural ministry that multiplies disciples, churches, leaders, and missionaries. The primary focus will be to help train, equip, and send African missionaries. The primary responsibilities of this role will be to lead the planning and execution of training activities and events. They will report to the team leader and will also work closely with the national leadership of VCP.



WEST AFRICA MISSIONARY MOVEMENT SPECIALIST

Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire

This role will be assigned to the West Africa Mission Coalition Project. The vision of this project team is to partner with the evangelical national church to motivate and equip nationals for near- and cross-cultural ministry that multiplies disciples, churches, leaders, and missionaries. This role will assist in the planning and execution of training activities and events.
