Titus has now been diagnosed with pneumonia. His oxygen saturation rates had dropped to below 60% (anything below 90% is problematic). They have him on oxygen and have admitted him to the ICU. Please be praying for this family who have been getting smacked by one large wave after another. Pray especially for Titus and for Kristin as she struggles with not being able to be by his side.
